SORNA Exchange Portal

The Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act (SORNA) requires jurisdictions to share information about sex offenders who are relocating between jurisdictions or required to register in more than one jurisdiction. The Department of Justice developed the SORNA Exchange Portal to meet this directive and provide jurisdictions with additional tools and resources.



The secure internet-based portal can be quickly and easily accessed by sex offender registration personnel, facilitating communication and information exchange between jurisdictions.

SORNA Exchange Portal Benefits:

- Provides a common environment for all SORNA jurisdictions to share information.
- Enables jurisdictions to share contact information—to connect with the right people about the right issues.
- Fosters cooperation among jurisdictions for a collaborative effort to improve public safety.
- Allows jurisdictions to notify each other of relocating offenders and those required to register in more than one jurisdiction.
